3. Glass Insert Doors

Glass insert cabinetry can make a kitchen appear bigger—and brighter. If you're worried about others seeing inside, there are lots of different glass types, as well as lighting strategies, that can make your glass insert cabinets as transparent or opaque as you want them to be. Corinne Gail Sadowsky of [Corinne Gail Interior Design](#) cautions, "Glass inserts are best suited to upper cabinets where feet, knees, small kids and animals won't run the risk of breaking them." Also they are expensive, as much as two to three times more than solid doors, and decorative glasswork can add to the price. For DIYers, there is the option of [adding them](#) yourself to your existing cabinetry.
